**1. Éric Béliveau provided both a verbal and a written update of a recent SQA discussion (ref to a previous SQA email)**

- Generally speaking, club activities continue to be covered by SQA insurance as long as club's follow Public Health guidelines.
- NG Racing is cancelled for this season
- There will be no weekend racing for any levels this season
  - Racing will occur during weekdays, unless Edelweiss has 80 Lux of lighting in the evening (this will be verified, but it appears unlikely for our hill.)
- No racing can take place in red zones
- While in an Orange Stage:
  - Training is permitted
  - During a race, a max of 25 people on the race course (including coaches and volunteers)
  - Therefore, we need to be yellow (both Qc. and Ontario sides) to be able to race.

**2. Discussion regarding options for billing race fees vs. training fees and discussion about options on how to send out billing to parents for race fees.**

- Decisions were taken by every other Ski racing club is to increase race fees to \$45 (from \$35.)
- Decision : charge full race fees and to rebate races in which athletes do not participate

**3. Update on Training protocol during pandemic from Mario G.**

- Athletes must arrive pre-dressed and finish putting on equipment in the car (no access to the lodge for this)
- 2 different start times to athletes
- 2 different lunch times
- Suggestion that we ask for firepits outside, similar to what they have at Ste-Marie.

- Mario will ask JS from Edelweiss.
- There will likely be a requirement to check temps. Thermometers have been purchased.

**4. Discussion regarding the possibility of extra training at Mont Edouard for late Nov. or early Nov. 30-Dec.4.**

- Depends on whether we are still in the red zone or not as SQA guidelines suggest we cannot travel if we are in a red zone.
- Each family would have to be in a family bubble. The club cannot facilitate / condone allowing other families to share rooms / carpool.
- Some other clubs may be going to Mont Edouard including NCO, but some others have already cancelled (including MSM.)
- Mario confirmed that this would be a club activity, not a Les Sommets activity.
- Concern regarding club liability was raised.
  - President EB will contact SQA to seek / confirm guidance.
  
- Received confirmation on Nov. 13 that all extra training at Mont Edouard for this fall has been cancelled.
